PARTNERING FOR PROTECTION: A UNIFIED APPROACH TO CHILD SAFETY

Child safety is everyone's responsibility and effective protection starts with strong partnerships.

This session offers an overview of North Dakota's Safety Framework practice model, the benefits of a coordinated approach, and how central intake for CPS works. Learn who should report suspected abuse, how to do it, and what happens next.

We'll also highlight the Handle with Care program, showing how law enforcement can collaborate with schools to support children exposed to trauma because timely communication can change a child's day, and their future.
